Fall Landscaping update

At the WROA Board Meeting on 18 Sept, the fall 2017 landscaping plan was presented, discussed, and accepted. This was also a Voting Members meeting.

Below is a summary of the actions planned and decisions:

1. The focus will be on monument fronts in need of beautification. A survey was conducted and a priority established. Dead plants will be removed and new plantings added. Consideration was given as to whether the monument is in the shade or sun. The planting zone we are in will also drive plant selection. Plantings will be done in the fall.
2. Furthermore, common ground Pear Trees suffering from Blight are also being evaluated. Some of the worse have been removed. Fortunately, the common ground Ash Tree degradation from EAB has slowed freeing up some 2017 budget. In the fall, Pear Tree Blight is evaluated and the worse are identified for removal the following year.
3. In addition, the beautification sub-committee has completed their survey and have identified circles that need further beautification.
