A. “Village Street Tree” Replacement Plan

1. A village, with leadership from its Voting Member and other involved residents, would first submit its Street Plan to the City of O’Fallon for approval. A village special committee may be the best approach.

If the village is structured as a Sub-Association, its Board of Directors would submit its Plan to the City.

The village would be responsible for keeping village residents informed, given the opportunity to participate in the planning, and decision making.

2. Upon approval by the city, the village will submit the Street Plan to the WROA Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for its review and approval.
3. The WROA is not responsible for planting or maintenance costs.
4. The ARC and CMA will maintain a file of approved Plans.

B. General Tree Replacement Advice

1. Always review the City of O’Fallon Ordinances for compliance.
2. Always call “DIG-RITE” before you dig. Visit their WEBSITE for further information and locate request timeline.
